Gerardo "Jerry" Casas, 47, of Huntley passed away suddenly Tuesday, May 12, 2020, at Northwestern Medicine Huntley Hospital in Huntley.

He was born March 21, 1973, in Elgin, the son of Jose Ignacio and Valentina (Gonzalez) Casas Sr. Jerry was raised in Elgin and attended St. Joseph Catholic School. He was a 1992 graduate of St. Edward High School. He met his wife, Lourdes and they shared their first kiss at the stroke of midnight, Jan. 1, 1997. He was a member of St. Mary Catholic Church in Huntley and the Knights of Columbus Council # 11666. He was a truck driver for Ozinga Trucking for six years.


