David Chester Rominski, 72, of Lanark, IL passed away peacefully surrounded by his wife and sons at Genesis Medical Center in Davenport, Iowa on September 16, 2021.

He was born on July 7, 1949, to parents Theodore Rominski and Fay (Suter)Schultz in Ashland, WI. He graduated from John Edwards High School, Port Edwards, WI in 1968.

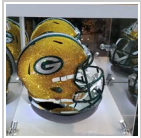
