Howard M. Berline, 94 of Huntley, formerly of White Hall, Illinois passed away on December 4, 2012

He was born October 22, 1918 in the Walkerville community the son of Lloyd and Mabel (Howard) Berline. He married Virginia Beth Neal on October 1, 1938 in St. Charles, Missouri.

Howard graduated from Illinois College in Jacksonville, IL and earned a Masters Degree in education from the University of Illinois. He was a veteran of World War II, having served in the United States Navy.

Mr. Berline coached and taught at schools in the White Hall, Hillview, Roodhouse and North Greene systems. He served as Assistant Principal of Greene County schools, a position he enjoyed very much, observing the fine teaching done in county schools. Howard was a member of the First Baptist Church of White Hall, White Hall Masonic Lodge, and the county Farm Bureau. During years spent farming in Greene County, he also served on the elevator board and the North Greene school board.

Howard was an avid sports fan, supporting the Uof I Fighting

Illini and the St. Louis Cardinals.
