Norm L. Schumacher, 85, of Huntley, passed away Saturday, March 29, 2014 at Heritage Woods in Huntley.

Norm was born in Old Carpentersville on August 25, 1928 the son of Frank and Louise (Ehlert) Schumacher. He was a 1946 graduate of Dundee High School. He was employed for several years with Elgin Water Softener Corp. and 14 years at Pure Oil Research Center as a test car driver. He was also employed for 23 years as a Supervisor for General Kinematics Corp. in Crystal Lake.

Norm was a former 29 yr. member of the Loyal Order of Moose and 18 yrs in Lodge #117 A.F. & A.M. He had received Honorable Discharges for serving 3 yrs each in the Illinois National Guard and the U.S. Air Force Reserves.
